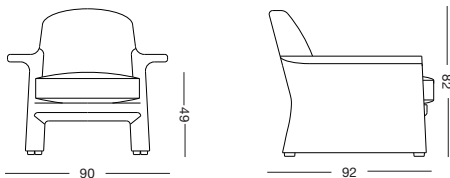
Matthew Hilton

Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply.
Black stained beech feet.

Upholstery: Zig-zag springs, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex & coconut fibres, needled wool, multi-density wool.

Cushions: Feather, latex and multi-density wool.
