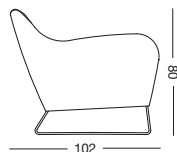

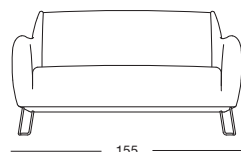

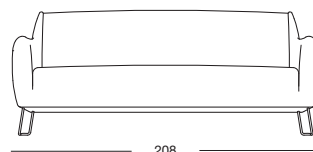
1. Armchair

Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply.

Stainless steel sledge legs.

Upholstery: Zig-zag springs, pocket springs, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex & coconut fibres, needed wool.
