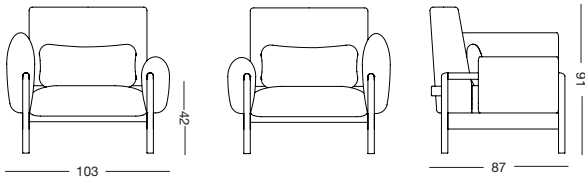

An armchair design with one arm lower than the other that acknowledges changes in the culture of sitting. Inspired by Bruno Munari's celebrated 1944 poster 'Seeking Comfort in an Uncomfortable Chair', the Bruno chair is intended to accommodate new gestures and a different language of sitting.

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Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply.
Oak or walnut legs.

Upholstery: Elasticated webbing, pocket springs, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex & coconut fibres, multi-density wool.

Cushions: Feather.
