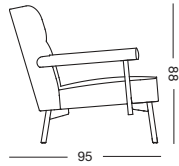
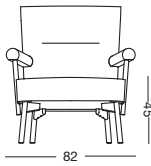

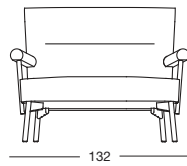
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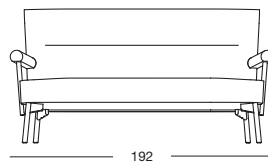
1. Armchair

## Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply.  
Turned ash legs and arms.

Upholstery: Elasticated webbing, pocket springs, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex & coconut fibres, multi-density wool, feather pads.
