Rachel Whiteread

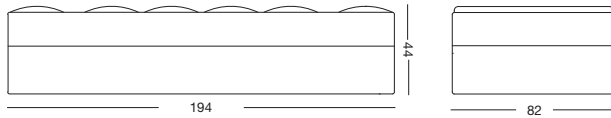


Originally designed by Rachel Whiteread as part of the Please Touch exhibition at SCP in 1999, a show of furniture pieces by contemporary artists.

The piece is closely related to a group of sculptures that Whiteread made in the early 1990s in rubber and plaster, which explored the space underneath a single bed.

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England. \*Please Note: this piece is unable to be made fully in natural materials and therefore contains multi density foam

### Designer

Born in London in 1963, Whiteread studied painting at what was then Brighton Polytechnic before specialising in sculpture at the Slade School of Fine Art. Her work is now internationally recognised and she has won several awards such as the Turner Prize in 1993.

Daybed for SCP is her first foray into furniture design, and was part of the Please Touch exhibition in 1999
