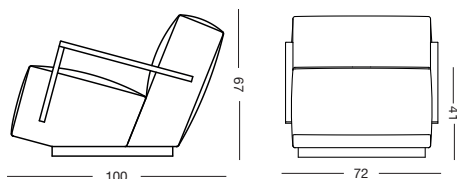


Created with space efficiency and city living in mind, the design is one of contrasting volumes, with large fully-upholstered sections set against slimline solid wood arms that utilise hidden fastenings for visual refinement. The frame has been engineered for strength and durability, while the makeup of the upholstery gives the design a real lounging comfort and the ability to spring back into shape.

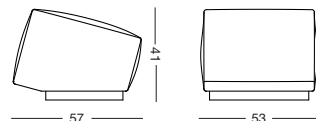

Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply.

Black stained plinth.

Upholstery: Zig-zag springs, pocket springs, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex & coconut fibres, multi-density wool.

Arms: Oak or walnut.
