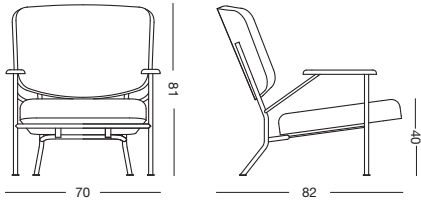

### Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: Tubular steel.

Upholstery: Elasticated webbing, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex & coconut fibres, multi-density wool.

Cushions: Feather, latex and latex and coconut fibre.
