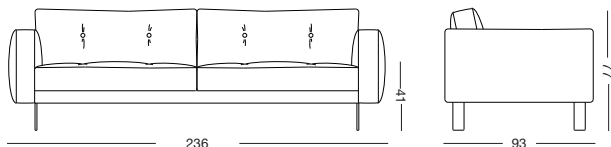

### Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply.  
Black powder coated steel legs.

Upholstery: Zig-zag springs, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, jute webbing, latex and coconut fibres, needled wool and multi-density wool.

Cushions: Feather and latex.
