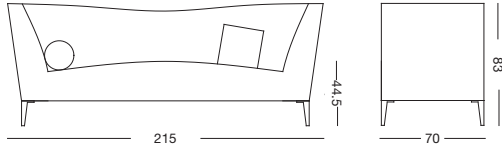
Jasper Morrison



Developing and launching a sofa in 1988 was a whole new direction for SCP. Morrison had created a number of versions of the design, including a chaise longue, and iterations with no back at all. SCP produced the most formal version: Sofa No.3, which had two armrests, a back and straight feet on all corners.

Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply.

Bright polished cast aluminum legs.

Upholstery: Zig-zag springs, coil springs, wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex and coconut fibres and needled wool.

Cushions: Feather.
