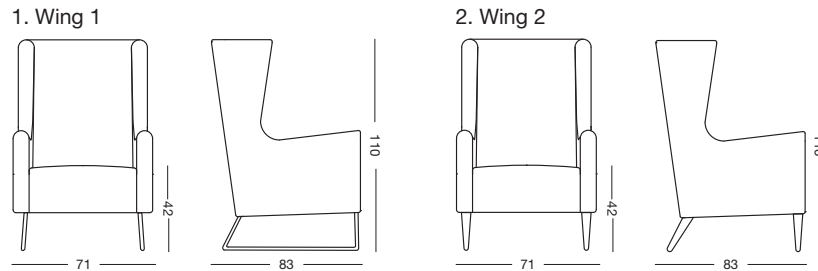

The Wing armchair is a modern interpretation of an old theme. The sharp defined angles and high back produce an austere and formal look. Wing 1 armchair features square arms and a stainless steel sledge base. Wing 2 has rounded arms and turned beech legs.

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Materials

Made at SCP's specialist upholstery factory in Norfolk, England, using entirely foam and fire-retardant free materials.

Frame: FSC beech and softwood ply. Stainless steel ledge legs or beech turned legs.

Upholstery: Wool interliner, burlap, recycled wool, latex & coconut fibres, multi-density wool.

Legs: Beech or stainless steel.
